The following may not play in the E league: Played on a roller or ice travel team; played on a varsity or club high school ice or roller team; played on a college ice or roller varsity or club team; been on a CORH E league "move list" and was not given permission to return to the E league; play on a CORH B or C league team. CORH reserves the right to remove E league players during a session if a player is judged to be too skilled for the E league. D teams are limited to two 2012 Winter CORH C league players. No CORH B league players may play in the D league and a maximum of 2 per C team. Current (2011/2012) college club/varsity roller or ice hockey players are only allowed in B league (except goalies) and no more than 2 per team.

Registration ends at 8:00pm Friday, December 30 for all leagues. League play begins January 4. You must hand in your registration, roster and \$200 non-refundable deposit by December 30. Your registration will not be accepted without all three items. All players must sign a waiver form if they haven't done so since July of 2007. All leagues will be 4 on 4 plus a goaltender using a puck. First 14 teams on a specific night will be accepted. Double headers will be necessary if a league has an odd number of teams. 3 penalty rule - any player receiving 3 minor penalties in one game will receive a game misconduct (too many men penalties not included). **If you receive a penalty while the other team is scoring, that penalty will count towards your limit of 3. If you receive a 4th minor penalty during a game you'll be given a one game suspension.**

Age: You must be at least 18 years of age to play in adult leagues.

Cost is \$1300 for twelve games and playoffs for qualifying teams. Fee covers rink, referees and scorekeeper. **\$50 discount if fees paid in full BEFORE first game.**

Pay policy: We will accept two payments from, and write a maximum of 2 receipts to, each team. One for the deposit and one for the remaining fees owed. We **will not** accept payments from individual players. We accept cash or checks only (make checks payable to CORH) - **no credit cards. Final payment is due before your 2nd week of the session. There is a \$50 penalty if league fees are not paid in full by the 2nd week.**

Roster must contain each player's first and last names and jersey number. Players may not be added after the 6th game. Each player is responsible for checking in at the scorer's table. **If you are not checked in on the scoresheet you will receive a delay of game penalty.** This also includes changing your number if you change jerseys. If a player is checked in but not on the bench, the team will receive a two minute unsportsmanlike penalty. You must play in one of the first five games to be eligible for the rest of the session. You must play in at least five regular season games to be eligible for the playoffs. Eligibility rules apply to goaltenders skating out.

Jerseys: You must have jerseys that are the same basic color (black isn't blue, red isn't orange) with permanent numbers (no tape) **by your first game.** Numbers must be readable from 1/2 court. **No duplicate numbers - including alternate color jerseys.** Jersey sleeves must cover elbow pads. Goalie jerseys do not have to match the rest of the team. **Home team changes in case of jersey color conflict.**

Games will start as early as 6:00pm and as late at 11:00pm Monday - Thursday. Be prepared to play **10 minutes before** your posted time (except for first game of the day). Each team must supply one good red or black puck for each game.

Game time is forfeit time. Teams that don't have the minimum number of players (that's 3 people) on the floor at game time will forfeit. Time outs may not be taken before the puck drops and your goaltender must be in the bench area, ready to play, or on the floor with more than 15 minutes remaining in the first half or you will forfeit.

Fighting rule: Fighting penalties will result in a game misconduct and at least a 3 game suspension. A second fighting penalty in a session will result in suspension for the rest of that session AND THE NEXT SESSION and possibly other punishment. This will be doubled during playoffs.

Major penalties: If a player receives a major penalty, they will also receive a game misconduct, one game suspension and possibly other sanctions.

Games will be two 20 minute running clock periods with time stopped in last minute of the first half and the last minute of a tied or one goal game. One 30 second time out per game per team. Three minutes between games. On penalties, the clock will stop when the player enters the penalty box.

Players may be on only one roster in a league. Goaltenders may play in any league and on as many teams as they like.

Chin Straps - Chin straps are mandatory and must be fastened.

Pants - Your knee/shin guards must be covered with hockey pants or socks.

Skates - No brakes on skates. No protruding screws. CORH reserves the right to ask player with skates that may damage the court to leave the playing surface. Skates must have appropriate number of wheels (if your skate has room for 4 wheels, all 4 wheels must be present) for the entire game..

Other equipment - you must wear elbow pads, hockey gloves, shin/knee guards and HECC certified helmet with a functioning chin strap. **We strongly encourage everybody to wear a full cage/face shield, mouth guard, cup/pelvic protector and girdle.**

Tobacco - no smoking/tobacco products in the building including the front walkway and the deck on the side of the building.

Alcohol - no alcohol is allowed in the building or in the parking lot. Consuming alcohol on the property, will result in a **one year suspension.**

Experience has proven that it is impossible to anticipate all problems which may arise when rules are formulated and adopted. Therefore, Central Ohio Roller Hockey reserves the right to waive any rule governing play in any league when in CORH's judgment, the application of said rule will result in gross unfairness and unreasonable hardship.
